2022 Lenten Journey “Growing Faith in the Home and Congregation”

Our Lenten Journey begins on Ash Wednesday, March 2, and continues through Easter Sunday, April 17. I would encourage every family to keep the Lenten Schedule, included with this newsletter, posted on their refrigerator and set aside the time to come to the Lenten meals and Mid-Week worship services. Lent, in our tradition, has been a time for deepening our relationship with God and those around us.

The Lenten messages this year will focus on how we can grow more fully into God by strengthening faith both in the home and in the congregation. “Faith come by hearing and hearing by the Word of God”. (Romans 10:17) It is our responsibility to pass on the faith to the next generation.

Vibrant Faith emphasizes that faith is formed by the power of the Holy Spirit through personal trusted relationships, often in our own homes. Martin Luther emphasized that the greatest pulpit is the kitchen table. Speaking to God in prayer especially at the family dinner table and engaging in faith conversation as a family is the most important way that we pass on the faith. Personal growth is really a by-product of prayer and is very important in and by itself but the main purpose of prayer is growing more deeply in our relationship with God.

Plan to attend the Lenten meals and the Lenten Services as families. Better yet, invite a friend.

PASSING ON THE FAITH

Join with us each Wednesday during Lent as we focus on the faith practices that enhance the passing on the faith to the next generation. Research studies have shown that the most important person in passing on the faith is the mother, next is the father.

I cannot emphasize enough how important the family and the extended family is in passing on the faith. It is so important to worship together and talk about the importance of faith in the home. This will be to focus of our Lenten time together this year.

Keep the Call Committee in Prayer

You may have heard that the candidate that the call committee had interviewed withdrew their name from consideration. This means that the call committee is back to receiving names of candidates from the South Dakota Synod and starting the process all over again.

Knowing how long the process will take is uncertain as you have experienced. Keep the process in prayer and remember the members of the call committee in prayer this is a challenging time for them.

The church's mission statement was recited by council members: "Sharing God's Word, Doing God's Work."

President Rob Thuringer called the January meeting of the council to order at 7:00 p.m.

Absent and excused were Tim Walburg, Corey Strom, Josh Van Dyke, and Kristin Morse.

Vice-president Danny Brown led the devotions reading the devotion for January 11, 2022, from *Christ in Our Home*.

The agenda was discussed, and two items were added—the report of the Nominating Committee and the sale of the church car. Motion by Jennifer Briggs to approve the agenda with the additional items. Seconded by Susan Farrell-Poncelet. Motion carried.

Motion by Danny Brown, seconded by Jennifer Briggs, to approve the minutes of the December 14, 2021, council meeting. Motion carried.

Reports

Pastor Bob Hansen asked that council members remember Pastor Solveig in prayer because her brother, Steve Larson, has passed away. Others to hold up in prayer include the families of Terry Heibult whose funeral was Monday, January 10 and Donna Oines whose funeral will be on Friday, January 14.

Trinity gained a new confirmation student this week as the result of kids inviting other kids. Trinity's confirmation students are living the mission of the church.

Confirmation students and guides will see the movie *American Underdog: the Kurt Warner Story* on January 26. It has a strong Christian message for the viewers.

Pastor Bob will have total knee replacement surgery on January 25. He will be absent Sunday, January 30 and Sunday, February 6, and possibly longer. Jim Iverson has received permission from the

bishop to administer communion on February 6.

The call process is moving forward, but because this is a slow and deliberate process, we should assume that we will not have a new pastor for a few months and it will be necessary to plan for Lent and Easter.

Deacon Suzanne Hansen reported that the senior high youth will also be attending the movie *American Underdog*.

The remaining \$5,625.00 due for the national youth gathering will be paid with funds from a savings account held by the Board of Parish Education.

President Thuringer will contact Joan Merager about serving as secretary at the annual meeting on January 23.

The call committee has met with a candidate on Zoom and the candidate has visited at Trinity. The committee is checking references and another Zoom meeting is possible. Some members have expressed a desire to have the candidate preach at Trinity before a call is extended. Pastor Bob advised against this practice and suggested that members check for online services led by the candidate instead.

Vice-president Brown had no report.

Jim Iverson gave the report from the Board of Deacons.

Evangelical Outreach—In response to a question about who is responsible for managing the new message board, it is the consensus of the Deacons that the board should be managed by the staff. The Office Manager already prepares the announcements for the bulletin every week. The Office Manager and the Receptionist are best positioned to manage the messages on the new message board.

Life and Growth—Letters have been sent to the February Service Group, and plans are being made for the Lenten soup suppers which will begin on Ash Wednesday, March 2.

Mission Momentum—The 2022 Mission of the Month Program was reviewed. It was agreed that we will spend the budgeted amount each month if no donations are received for that mission. Any donations that are received will be applied to the budgeted amount. If donations exceed the budgeted amount, the mission will receive the amount of the donations. Motion by Jim Iverson, seconded by Jennifer Briggs, to approve the plan for the Mission of

the Month with the change in the amount available for The Gathering to \$800. Motion carried. Trinity will serve The Gathering on Monday, August 29, 2022.

Services and Sacraments—Pastor Bob will be on medical leave on Sunday, January 30 and Sunday, February 6. We need to find a worship leader and pulpit supply for January 30. Jim Iverson will celebrate Holy Communion on Saturday evening, February 5 and at the services on Sunday, February 6.

Worship and Music—Covid-19 is still a concern. The infection rate is increasing again and needs to be monitored.

Dana Hoff reported that the Trustees had approved the bills.

Sid Gulbranson reminded the members that natural gas prices have increased dramatically in the last year, and that increase is reflected in the 2022 mission plan.

Susan Farrell-Poncelet gave the report for Parish Education.

The report included these items previously reported: confirmation and high school students will attend the movie, *American Underdog*; the final payment for the youth attending the National Youth Gathering will be made using savings held in Parish Education accounts.

Jennifer Briggs reported that the Bingo Bash is scheduled for January 30. Lori Schultz suggested postponing the event because of the increasing rates of Covid infections. It was agreed to leave the schedule as it is, but to continue to monitor the infection rates and keep the option to postpone the event open.

Business

Annual meeting will follow the 11:00 a.m. service on Sunday, January 30. Tom Farrell will act as parliamentarian if he is in town. Pastor Bob will serve as parliamentarian if Tom Farrell is not available.

The president will read the guidelines for discussion and voting which are recorded in the minutes of the previous annual meeting.

Motion by Jennifer Briggs, seconded by Becky Brown, to bring the following motion to the annual meeting: Motion to surplus the church car and to authorize the council to sell it. Motion carried.

Mission Plan for the coming year was presented by vice-president Danny Brown. It is more realistic than those of previous years and will use money from multiple savings accounts (\$114,900) to offset expenses. For example, the congregation has realized

savings while being without a full-time pastor and youth director. The proposed mission plan would use \$9,651.81 from the Demand Account to offset the pastor's housing allowance. The Demand Account is the accumulated interest from the parsonage CDs and was intended for this purpose. Additionally, Trinity is no longer a congregation of 1,700. The congregation is now estimated at 1,025 members, and mission plan reflects that decrease. In the course of the discussion, Pastor Bob alerted the council to the need to change the congregation's status recorded at the synod office. The status currently states that Trinity is a congregation in transition for calling a pastor and in transition waiting to call an associate pastor. The decision was made earlier to forego calling an associate pastor in the near future. The congregation will call a full-time faith formation director. Motion by Becky Brown, seconded by Jennifer Briggs, to accept the proposed mission plan. Motion carried.

Updating member status/information has been an ongoing project led by Lora Erslund. The consensus of those present that the next steps would include printing a list of active members with current contact information; place currently inactive members with no contact information on a remove list; and move active members with no contact information to the inactive list.

Pastor Bob pointed that no vital statistics has been entered in the church's Permanent Record for about 8 years. No action was taken.

Report of the Nominating Committee was given by Becky Brown, committee chair.

Mission Kits

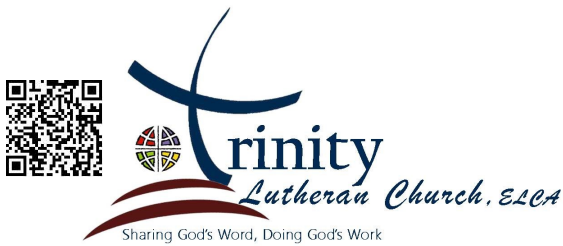
